

The Door County Sail & Power Squadron, in cooperation with the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) conduct boating and personal watercraft safety courses for the public. Classes are suitable for boaters of all ages beginning as early as age 12.

All classes are presented by certified boating safety instructors. Participants that pass a written exam earn a Wisconsin DNR safe boating certificate. The Certificate also allows boaters between the ages 12-16 skipper privileges.

USPS and DNR Certificates normally qualify adult boat owners for discounts with their respective insurance companies. Students under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to insure successful completion of the class.
