

Log On at usps.org

Your PIN was sent in the mail to you on the same card paper as your membership card. However, to use it you must first select a Security Question and Answer.

Selecting a Security Question and Answer:

1. Click [here](#) to get on the Security Question Selection page.
2. Enter your certificate number.
3. Select your security question
4. Click the continue button.
5. Enter the answer to your selected question.
6. RECORD THIS SOMEWHERE IF YOU CAN'T REMEMBER.
7. Logoff. You're now able to Log on using your PIN. Click [here](#)

If you get a logon failure notice, follow this procedure:

1. Click on the "[ReSubmit](#)" button
2. Click on the link for the "[Security Information](#)" page.
3. Enter your certificate number
4. If you do not remember your security question
 - a. Click on I don't know my security question
 - b. Click Continue
 - c. Your Security Question will be sent to your email address of record in the national membership database. If it does not arrive check 8 a and b.
5. If you know your security question
 - a. Click on I know my security question
 - b. Select your security question
 - c. Click Continue
6. Enter the answer to your security question
7. Click Continue
8. Your PIN will be sent to your email address of record in the national membership database
 - a. If you do not receive it, please check your JUNK email box.
 - b. If you have a Spam Filter on your email, add nobody@usps.org to the "Never Block Sender" list. Start over at Step 5 (I know my security question).
5. Go to [Login Page](#), enter your certificate number, PIN and mark the box "Remember These Values?". Click on the Continue button.

We suggest that everyone change their password/PIN to something they can remember.

Changing Your PIN:


1. Click [here](#) and Login to www.usps.org.
2. When you get the Welcome screen
2. Go to the "[Manage Your Security Information](#)" it will present the Security Question Setup/Change PIN screen
3. Choose the second option of the first question – "I want to Change My PIN".
4. Enter your current PIN and click on Continue.
5. Enter your NEW PIN, and the same NEW PIN again in the Confirm PIN, box.

A Few Items to Remember:

1. A PIN must be from 6 to 8 characters in length; no embedded blanks are allowed; PINs are case insensitive, all lower case letters are converted to capitals. They must contain at least 1 character and 1 number. They may also contain any of the characters ".", " ", "#", "\$", "*", and "_".
2. The National website uses Cookies to remember who you are and to allow you access to each page, without having you login every time you change pages. You need to have your Internet Browser set to accept cookies.
